## Subject:Preliminary market consultationWarehousing and Distribution Services

Dear Madam/Sir,

The Publications Office of the European Union (hereinafter referred to as 'the OP') is the official provider of publishing services to all institutions, bodies and agencies established by or under the EU treaties. As such, it constitutes the central point of access to EU law, and also to publications, data, research results, procurement notices, and other official information. The OP therefore plays a central role in informing the public about what the EU does and means for them, and in unlocking the power of data.

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The OP is currently reflecting on its future warehousing and distribution services.

In this context, the OP has decided to launch this preliminary market consultation in accordance with Article 169(1) and with Point 15 of Annex 1 to Regulation 2024/2509<sup>1</sup> to:

- gain general market knowledge (existence of sufficient suppliers to ensure effective competition);
- assess the capability of the market to deliver what is required, within the required time-limits and on the required scale, and consequently the feasibility of the envisaged procurement procedure;
- gain knowledge of the terms and conditions usually applied to contracts in the relevant market and identify potential market constraints;

- refine and further clarify its requirements and specifications without, however, having its needs influenced and determined by what the market offers;
- make a correct estimate of the future contract value;
- gain understanding of potential risks of contract performance.

To facilitate the consultation, we have prepared a questionnaire that will serve as a starting point for our exchange.

Following the receipt of your contributions, we might propose to meet with you in order to discuss your replies in more depth. If so, the meeting will be organised virtually (via Teams) and will last around two hours.

Please note that your replies to our questionnaires as well as any information exchanged during the potential meeting will remain confidential for the sole use of the OP in our reflections and will not be disclosed to any third party.
